

## NON RECYCLABLE ITEMS - RSU

### WHAT TO DIFFERENTIATE?

Anything that is not recyclable, such as toys, rubber, rags, pottery shards, dirty and waxy paper, unlit cigarette butts, tickets, pens, lighters, vacuum cleaner dust, audio tapes, cd, dvd and vinyl records etc..

### HOW TO SEPARATE YOUR WASTE?

Throw the undifferentiated waste into the gray bag that has been provided to you and leave it outside your door if you live in an area with door-to-door collection service or put it in the gray community recycling bin nearby your home if you live in an area with proximity service.

#### for HOUSEHOLDS (UND)

**Rules:** prior authorization is required for the access to the center, which certifies compliance with TARI obligations in the reference territory and possession of the authorizations for the transport of waste in the National Register of Environmental Managers.

#### OPENING ONLY FOR HOUSEHOLDS (UD)

Monday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday 7:30 to 11:30; Tuesday and Thursday 9:30 to 11:30 and 14:00 to 16:00. **Rules:** to access the Center it is requested a copy of a valid identity document certifying your residence in the municipalities that can access the Center, or a TARI bill for second home owners.

## PAPER AND CARDBOARD

### WHAT TO DIFFERENTIATE?

Newspapers, magazines, photocopies, books, notebooks and non-plastic coated brochures, paper and cardboard packaging, Tetra Pak® packaging, paper bags.

### HOW TO SEPARATE YOUR WASTE?

Throw paper and cardboard into the blue bin that has been provided to you and leave it outside your door if you live in an area with door to door collection service. Throw paper and cardboard without any bag in the **blue** community recycling bin nearby your home if you live in an area with proximity service.



## PLASTIC PACKAGING AND CANS

### WHAT TO DIFFERENTIATE?

Plastic bottles and containers, disposable plastic dishware such as plates and glasses, fruit and vegetable nets, polystyrene food containers and packaging, food boxes and jars, cans, aluminium or steel caps, aluminium tubes (such as creams and toothpaste tubes), aluminum foil food containers and foil sheets.

### HOW TO SEPARATE YOUR WASTE?

Throw plastic and metals waste into the **yellow** bag that has been provided to you and leave it outside your door if you live in an area with door-to-door collection service or put it in the yellow community recycling bin nearby your home if you live in an area with proximity service.



## GLASS

### WHAT TO DIFFERENTIATE?

Glass bottles and jars, glass containers

### HOW TO SEPARATE YOUR WASTE?

**Households:** put the glass into the **green** bell you find near your house.

**NON-households:** follow the instructions on the calendar dedicated to your business.



## BIO-WASTE

### WHAT TO DIFFERENTIATE?

Food waste, food leftovers, spoiled food separated from packaging, tea, chamomile and herbal tea filters, coffee grounds, dirty paper napkins (Scottex type) small amounts of cut leaves and flowers, corks and wooden sticks.

### HOW TO SEPARATE YOUR WASTE?

Throw the organic waste into your private garden into the compost bin that has been supplied to you following the correct composting methods; or throw the bio- waste in biodegradable bags into the brown community recycling bin nearby your home if you live in a proximity service area; or leave the brown bin with the organic waste, outside your door if you live in a door-to-door area service.
