YES PAPER / CARDBOARD / CARDBOARD PACKAGING, ENVELOPES AND PAPER BAGS, CARDBOARD BOXES, CARDBOARD PACKAGES SUCH AS RICE, PASTA AND OTHER FOODS, EGG PACKS, TETRAPAK PACKAGING, CONTAINERS FOR MILK / FRUIT JUICES AND OTHER BEVERAGES, NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES, BOOKS, NOTEBOOKS, PAPER SHEETS

NO GREASEPROOF PAPER, WAXED PAPER, LAMINATED FOOD PACKAGING (POLY-COUPLED MATERIALS TO BE DISPOSED OF WITH NON-RECYCLABLE ITEMS), USED PAPER TISSUES, RECEIPTS (CHEMICALLY COATED / THERMAL PAPER), CARBON COPY PAPER

YES **ANY TYPE OF PLASTIC PACKAGING ABLE TO CONTAIN A PRODUCT.** EMPTY AEROSOLS, ALUMINUM CONTAINERS, TINFOIL, METAL JARS, TIN CANS, METAL BOXES, TIN CONTAINERS, METAL CAPS / COVERS, PLUGS, PLASTIC AND METAL COVERINGS, FOOD TRAYS (VEGETABLES, CURED MEATS, CHEESES), YOGURT CONTAINERS, SNACK BAGS, FOOD FILM, CELLOPHANE AND PACKAGING FILM, FRUIT AND VEGETABLE NETS, PLASTIC BOXES, PLASTIC EGG PACKS, SAUCE TUBES, TOOTHPASTE TUBES, WASHING LIQUID / SHAMPOO / DETERGENT BOTTLES, POLYSTYRENE FOR PACKAGING, PLASTIC PLATES AND GLASSES, COAT HANGERS

NO RUBBER, KITCHEN UTENSILS, PLASTIC CUTLERY, BOWLS AND BUCKETS, PENS AND MARKERS, RULERS AND SET-SQUARES, RUBBER HOSES, BROKEN TOYS, MUSICAL CDS / DVDs, CHAIRS, SAUCERS, SYRINGES, SPECTACLES, NAPPIES

YES BOTTLES, JARS, GLASSES,
JUGS

NO FLAT GLASS (FROM PICTURES, WINDOWS, MIRRORS ETC...), CERAMIC,
PORCELAIN, SPECTACLES, PYREX, CRYSTAL, BULBS, NEON BULBS

GLASS MUST NOT BE PUT IN PLASTIC BAGS BUT DIRECTLY INTO THE GREEN RECYCLING BINS



ORGANIC

FOOD AND VEGETABLE WASTE

COOKING WASTE, FRUIT AND VEGETABLE WASTE, FRESH BREAD, OUT OF DATE AND DETERIORATED FOODS, GROUND COFFEE, TEABAGS, EGG SHELLS, FRUIT SKINS, FRUIT PITS / STONES, ANIMAL AND FISH BONES AND INNARDS. CUT PLANTS AND PRUNING WASTE IN SMALL QUANTITIES.

USED PAPER NAPKINS AND TISSUE PAPER, SMALL QUANTITIES OF COLD ASHES, HAIR

FOR THE ORGANIC COLLECTION USE ONLY BIODEGRADABLE AND COMPOSTABLE BAGS

ALL MATERIALS THAT CANNOT BE RECYCLED

NO DIFFERENTIATED REFUSE, BULKY ITEMS, MATERIAL FROM CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION, HAZARDOUS WASTE

FOR NON-RECYCLABLE WASTE IT IS PREFERABLE TO USE TRANSPARENT PLASTIC BAGS

TIMING

AFTER 21:00 ON THE EVENING BEFORE THE COLLECTION DAY.

BEFORE 05:00 ON THE MORNING OF THE COLLECTION DAY.



DOOR TO DOOR COLLECTION

USE THE CORRECT RECYCLING BIN FOR EACH KIND OF REFUSE, GIVING ATTENTION TO THE IDENTIFICATION OF THE MATERIAL: **GLASS, PLASTIC, PAPER, NON-RECYCLABLE, ORGANIC, AND TO THE DAY OF COLLECTION.** WASTE LEFT OUT ON DAYS OTHER THAN THOSE INDICATED ON THE CALENDAR, OR NOT CONFORMING TO THE REGULATIONS, WILL NOT BE COLLECTED. **POSITION THE RECYCLING BIN OUTSIDE YOUR HOME** PREFERABLY UNDER THE HOUSE NUMBER, AND AFTER THE COLLECTION, RETRIEVE YOUR OWN RECYCLING BIN TO AVOID CLUTTER AND THEFT. CRUSH CARDBOARD WELL TO REDUCE VOLUME.

NAPPIES

NAPPIES WILL BE COLLECTED **ON THE SAME DAY AS THE NON-RECYCLABLE MATERIAL.** IT IS ALSO POSSIBLE TO MAKE **SPECIFIC REQUESTS** TO HAVE THEM COLLECTED WITH THE **ORGANIC WASTE**, USING THE NON-RECYCLABLE BIN.



GARDEN CUTTINGS AND PRUNING WASTE

GARDEN CUTTINGS MAY BE LEFT OUT ON **ORGANIC COLLECTION DAY.** THE MATERIAL MUST BE ENCLOSED IN A BIODEGRADABLE OR COMPOSTABLE BAG. PRUNING WASTE MUST BE BOUND IN BUNDLES. A MAXIMUM OF 10 KG OF WASTE WILL BE ACCEPTED AT ANY ONE TIME.
